
Measuring Your Upright Freezer/Refrigerator



Notes:

- For the Depth of your fridge (measurement E), measure the body of the refrigerator only measure the depth of the doors (measurement D) separately. For Measurement D (door depth), measure at the thickest point (should be the middle of the door).
- For Measurement C (door handles), measure from the edge of the door inwards to the farthest edge of the door handle this helps us account for door handles that aren't mounted flush to the edge of the door. For B¹ measurement, measure the length of the door that the handle covers at the farthest points. Do not measure the handle along the raised (curved) area, as that will give a false (longer) measurement.
- Measurements B & F may not match, depending on the body and door style of your fridge, so it is important to take both.
